Research Question
Is your research question stated in the form of a question?
Is your research question focused around a small number of variables?
Did you formulate your research question into a hypothesis?
Can you go into a great amount of depth for your topic? (your topic isn't too broad or
complex)
Your topic is not already well known and documented in standard textbooks.
Abstract
Does your ABSTRACT have your research question, scope of the essay (theme) and the
conclusion (your thesis statement)?
Does your ABSTRACT include a short description of how the research was conducted?
(description of the methodology and scope of the study)
Is your ABSTRACT under the 300 word limit?
Table of Contents
Did you include an accurate TABLE OF CONTENTS?
Introduction
Is your research question clearly and exactly focused, and stated in both your
abstract and introduction?
Does your introduction explain the significance and context of your topic?
Does your introduction explain why your topic is worthy of investigation?
Does your introduction explain how the research question relates to existing
knowledge?
Did you correctly APPLY your research question to the field of chemistry? (experimental
design)
Investigation
Do you have a reasoned and convincing argument in relation to your research
question?
Does your essay contain arguments / interpretations based on scientific data?
If you used data taken from written sources did you clearly explain how the data was
selected and about its reliability? Did you use primary sources?
If you used data based on your own experimental work did you clearly explain how the
data was selected and about its reliability?
Did you present your analyzed and processed data so it relates directly to your research
question? (No raw data shown in this section)
Did you include sufficient information on your experimental methodology? Did you
provide enough information for someone to easily repeat your experimental work?
Did you justify your method approach and not simply report it?
Did you explain the theory behind any techniques or apparatus used?
Did you include awareness of any limitations or uncertainties inherent in your techniques
or apparatus?
Did you include awareness of any limitations or uncertainties inherent in your techniques

You only used diagrams to enhance your argument. All diagrams are labeled. Did you run a spell/grammar check and make corrections?
Reasoned Argument
Your essay provides a backbone for a reasonable argument. Did you compare different approaches and methods that are directly relevant to the research question?
You did not write a straightforward descriptive or narrative account without any analysis
References
Do you have appropriate primary sources? Did you reference them correctly?
Do you have extensive source references? (footnotes, endnotes, or in-text) Have you given references for all of your sources and not plagiarized?
If you used websites are you sure of their reliability?
Did you reference all illustrations, diagrams, or drawings used from other sources? You didn't use Wikipedia as a source.
Conclusion
Are all your conclusions based on the data, information and/or evidence? Does your conclusion relate directly to the research question?
Does your conclusion relate uncerty to the research question? Does your conclusion point out and explain any unexpected outcomes?
Does your conclusion answer your research question? If not, did you point out any
unresolved issues?
Does your conclusion include suggestions about further investigations that could be conducted on your research?

Works Cited / Bibliography
Do you have <i>at least</i> ten sources in your works cited page?

secondary sources, etc.?
Are all your internet sources cited correctly according to your manual of style?
Do each of your sources have the author, title of publication, place of publication, publisher & date of publication?
Formal Presentation
Title Page w/ word count? (Title, name and candidate number, date, word count)
Table of Contents? Page numbers?
Page numbers? Appendices (if appropriate)?
Under 4000 words and over 3000 words?
Holistic Judgement
